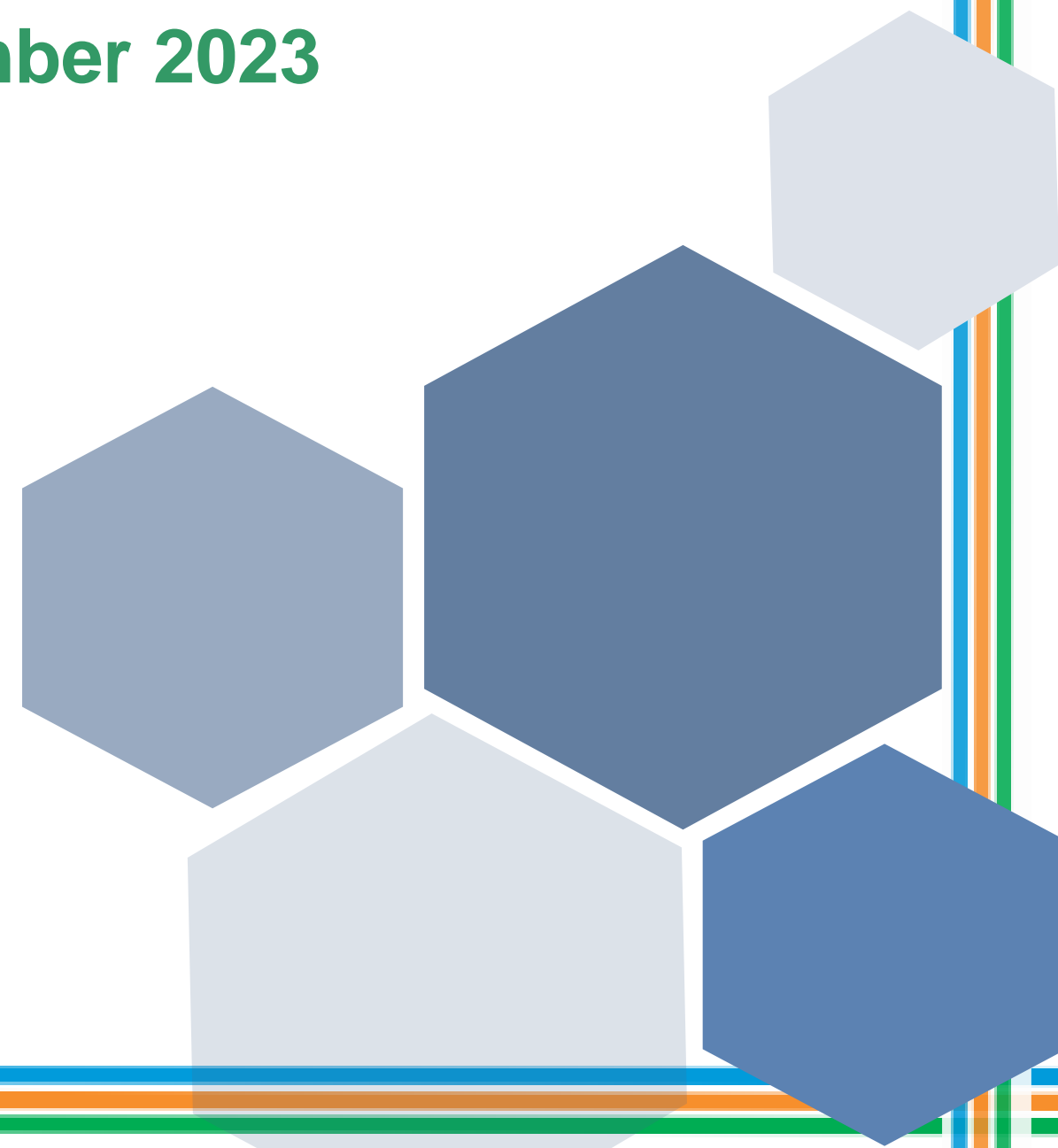

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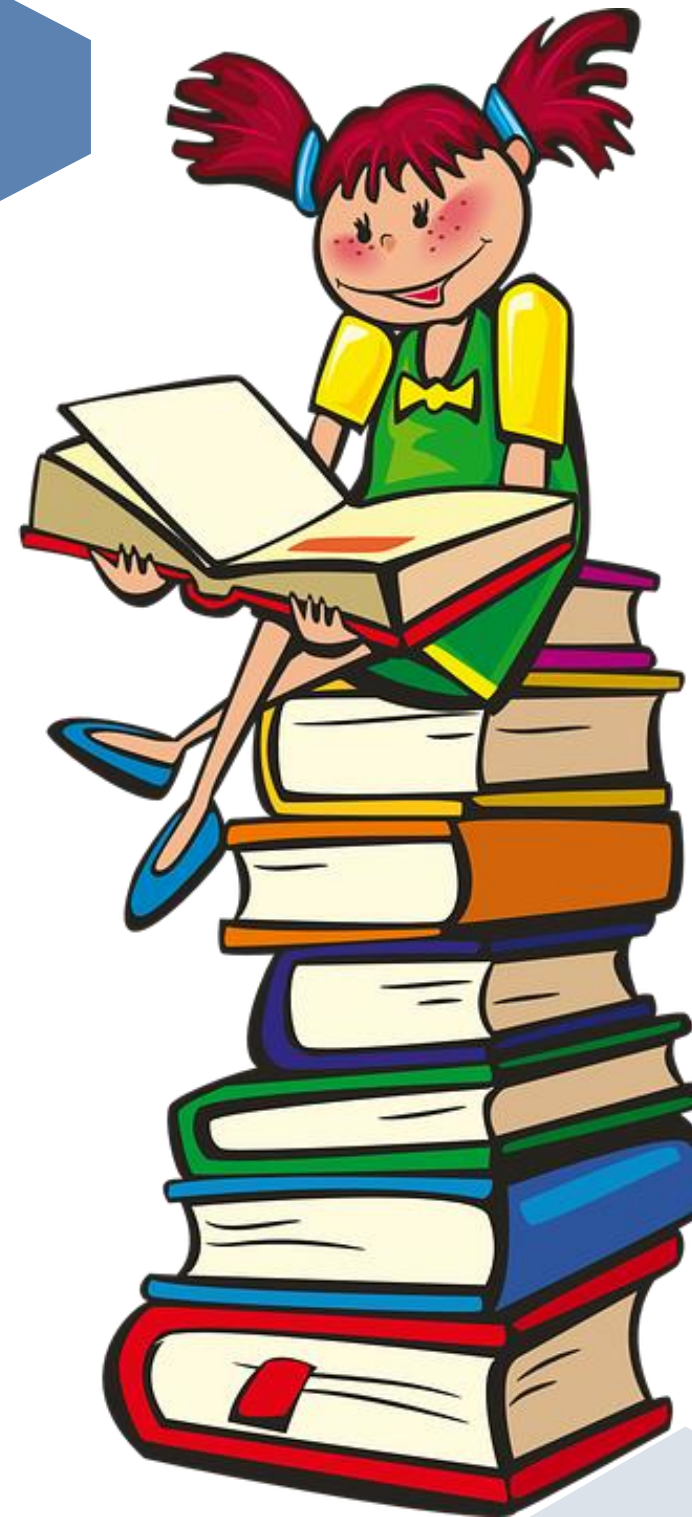

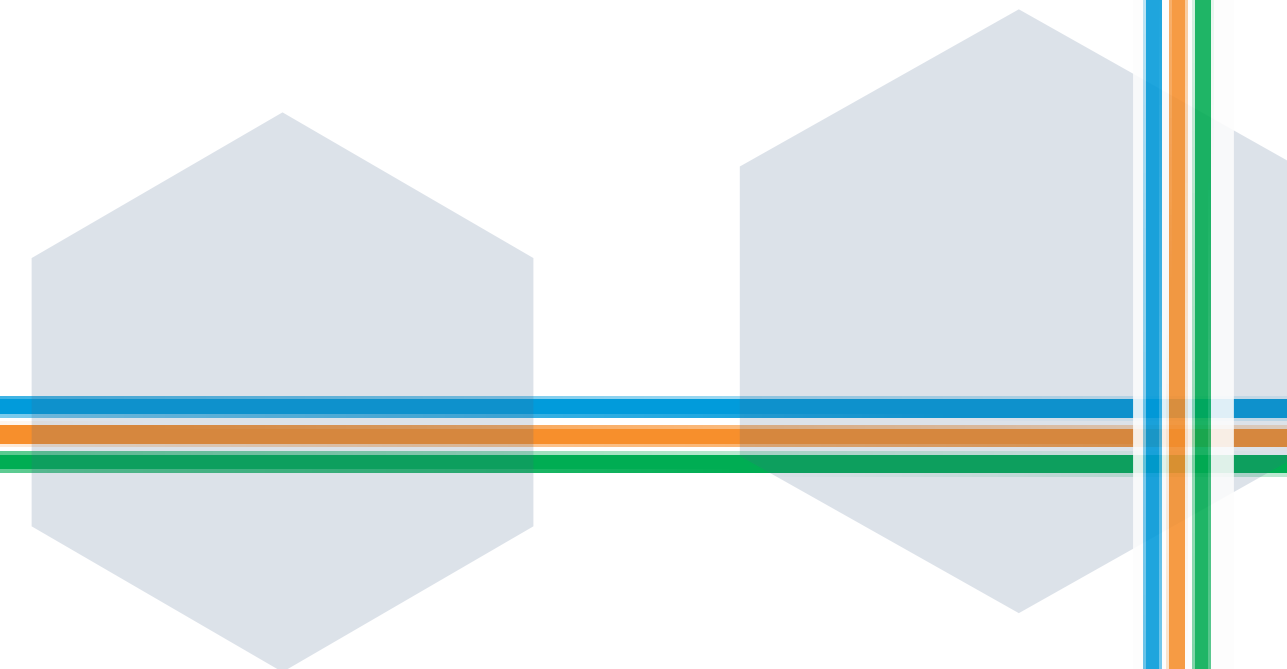


Module 1: Three Pillars of ESG

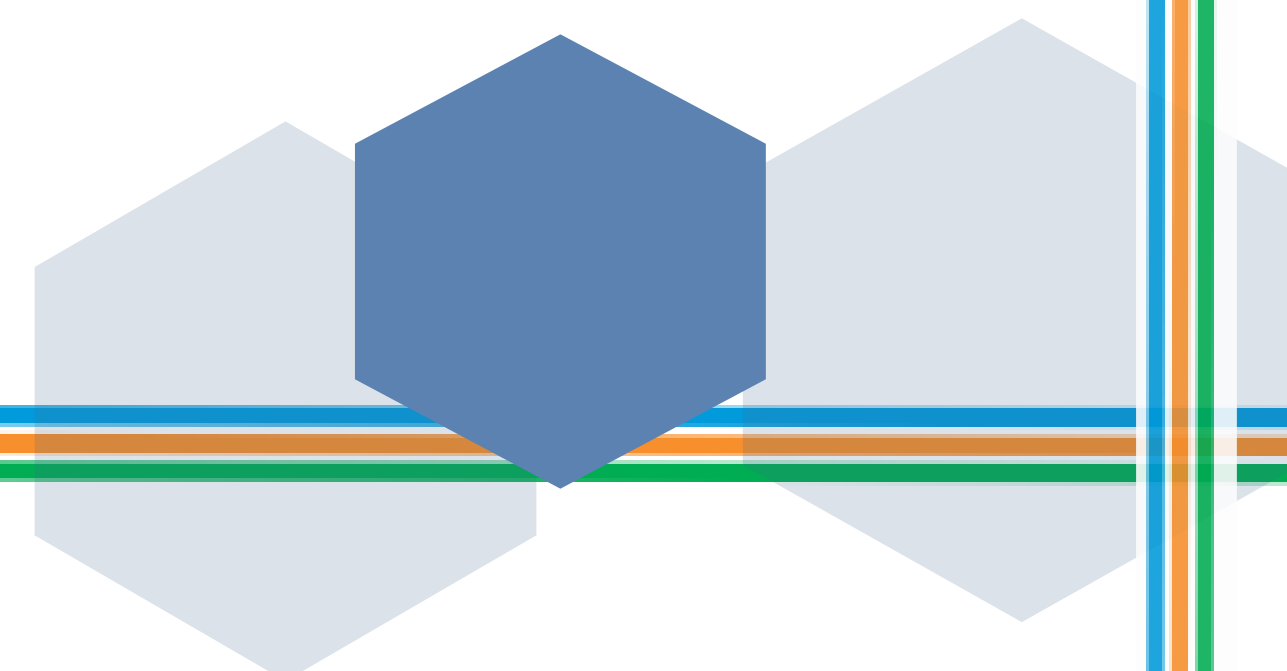
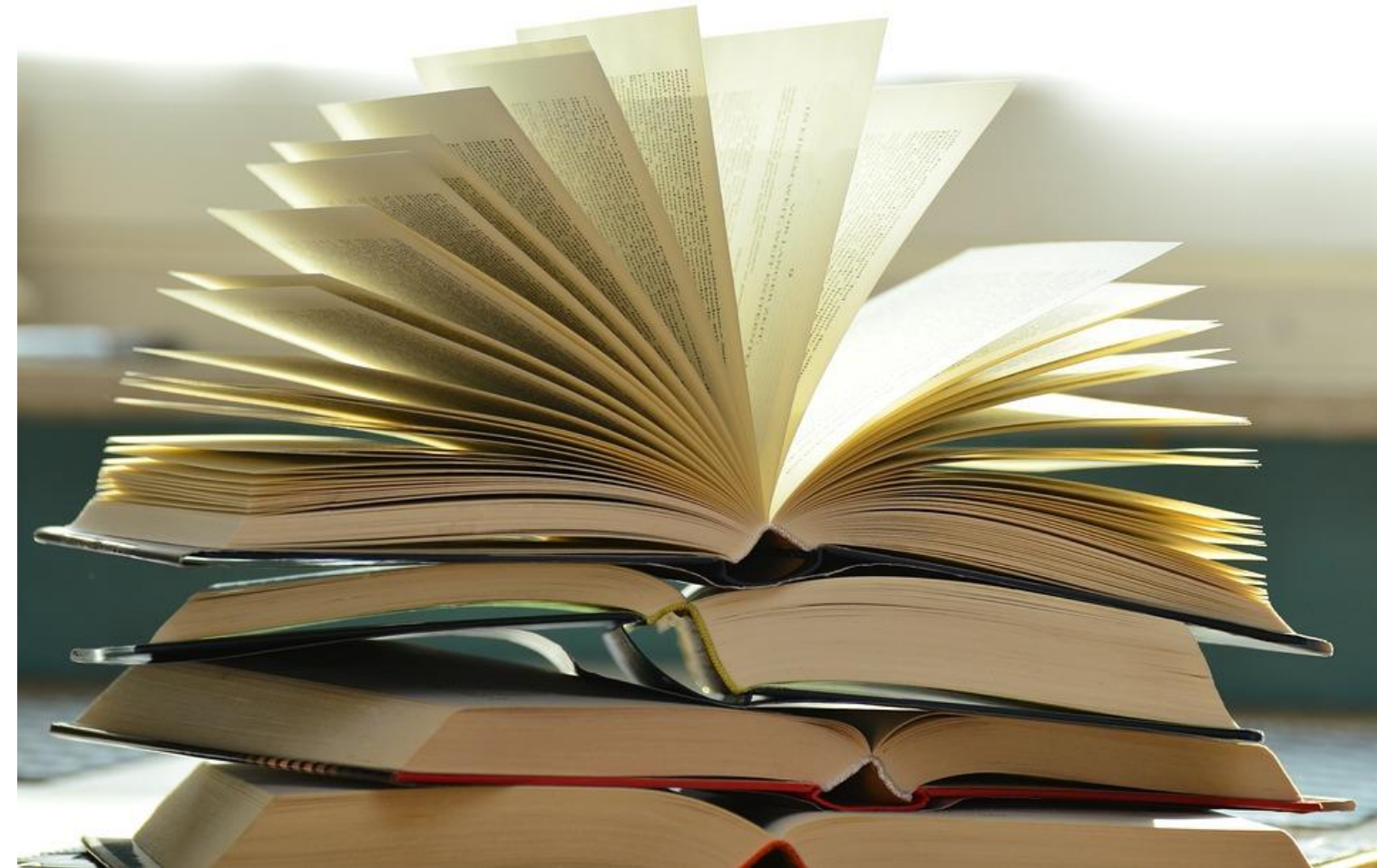


Module 3: ESG Frameworks


